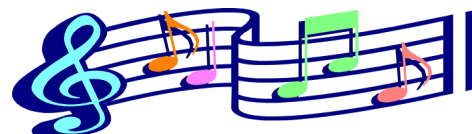
This has been a great project – mostly thanks to Georgia who weekly worked with our children, those who volunteered to help each Sunday, and to all of you who generously contributed and made it possible.

**August 25**

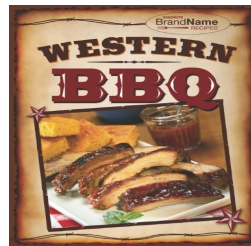
As our minister, Reverend Ian Kellogg will be on holidays in August.
